Triarchic Theory of Intelligence Just two years later, in 1985, Robert Sternberg proposed a three-category theory of intelligence, integrating components that were lacking in Gardner's theory. This theory is based on the definition of intelligence as the ability to achieve success based on your personal standards and your sociocultural context.
