It is the responsibility of the crane operator to cease crane operations whenever deficiencies are identified in an inspection, or when wind speeds or adverse weather conditions could affect the safe operation of the crane. The crane operator must obey a stop (or emergency stop) signal no matter who gives it. The operator also has the authority to stop operation whenever there is a concern as to safety. The operator can refuse to handle loads until a qualified person has determined that ...
