Prune very tall varieties of sunflowers in June or July. Maximilian sunflowers (*Helianthus maximiliani*) and Mexican sunflowers (*Tithonia diversifolia*) should be trimmed in June or July.This will reduce the sunflowers' size from their typical height of 9 feet (2.7 m) or greater to a much more manageable 4 feet (1.2 m). Maximilian sunflowers can also be left standing through the winter months ...
