Verify employment history and do work history check

The Social Security Administration (SSA) keeps track of employment history for the purposes of disability and retirement payments, and you can request a statement from the SSA at no charge. A detailed employment history, however, will cost between \$15 and \$80 for a time period covering one to 40 years. Locate the nearest social security office.
