Year-round sun protection is important for children in Queensland, as the UV Index. 1. is typically at damaging levels even during winter. Our schools take sun safety seriously and implement a range of strategies to support school environments that protect students from the damaging effects of the sun. Much of the sun exposure that causes skin damage occurs in childhood and adolescence. By the age of 15 many children have developed irreversible skin damage from exposure to the sun.

In turn, employees have a responsibility for their own safety and health and must follow UV protection policies and use sun protective measures provided. Cooperation between employers and employees can help minimise UV exposure in the workplace, this may include: reducing the amount of time outdoor workers spend in the sun
